Since its initiation in 1996, GRENED has been assisting students from both secondary and tertiary level educational institutions. This year was no different. GRENED continues to support students from 7 Secondary Schools in three parishes, College and University.

After being interviewed by members of the GRENED board on August 18th 2017, twelve (12) students were awarded a scholarship and the remaining seventeen (17) GRENED scholarships were renewed.

Each student received a yearly scholarship of one thousand five hundred dollars, (\$1,500.00), towards meals, transportation, tuition and other necessary school supplies.

Given our mission and vision GRENED seeks to create leaders amongst its students; to do so GRENED carefully look at each students needs
