### APPLICANT'S INFORMATION BRIEF

The Grenada Education and Development Programme, GRENE D, offers an opportunity to rural school-aged children to develop their interest in service, leadership and academic excellence. The programme provides mentoring, programming and financial awards. All interested persons must meet the following criteria:

1. **Be nominated** by a school principal, teacher or counsellor; a leader in the community or nation; someone who wishes to be a mentor or patron; or a representative of an organization or institution. Immediate family members of a potential recipient cannot nominate a child. A potential recipient cannot nominate herself or himself.
2. Must be academically strong, **not below 65% or B average**. Candidates meeting all other criteria but falling below a 65% average can apply, giving a written explanation from a school authority.
3. Must show promise of making a contribution in the public, and have preferably have **already been engaged in leadership and or service** in school, community, other.
4. Must have **evidence of family support and community bonding and connection**.
5. Must **commit to attending GRENE D events** for personal development, learning, fun.
6. Must accept and practice GRENE D's values of love, kindness, compassion, respect, positive ambition and must not be disposed toward or engaging in violence.
7. Must not be a loner and must be willing to socialise and work with other students in the programme and the GRENE D staff / team.
8. be a well-rounded youth who likes to excel, to lead, to have fun, enjoys friendships, creativity and learning.

Once admitted on this basis, a recipient's academic and overall performance will be reviewed along these lines. Failure to consistently not meet these terms can result in probation and possible termination from the programme.
